Invite legislators, friends, and colleagues to attend Wabanaki Alliance's Indigenous Peoples Day Live Stream. Monday October 11: 10 -10-30 Press conference filmed at State House complex followed at around 10:30 by larger cultural, informative event .

Join with those who will volunteer to leave a message on Janet Mills phone on IPD itself, urging her to support LD 1626

Reach out to Gov. Janet Mills often to urge passage of LD 1626. Refer to Wabanaki Alliance's talking points to guide your message, if desired.

Stay in contact with your legislators in discussion about LD 1626 urging passage of LD 1626. Take advantage of Wabanaki Alliance's talking points if needed. You might also want to suggest that they reach out to fellow legislators who might be swayed to vote yes.

Reach out to friends, businesses with whom or which you connect to share what you have learned about LD 1626, the blocks imposed by the 1980 Maine Indian Claims Settlement Act, and possible helpful actions.

Contact friends who may live in districts with legislators who will not automatically vote YES on LD 1626 but who might be open for discussion and change, and encourage them to reach out those legislators to educate and encourage them.
